Currently registered as a Registered Technologist with Computed Tomography (CT) Designation by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) or registered within six (6) months from date of hire for CT eligible candidates required

Willing to travel 80-90% of the time. Travel will be reimbursed.
